

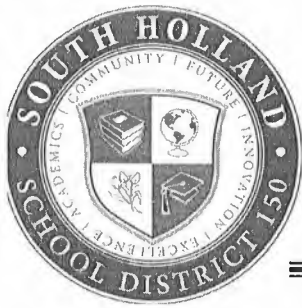

The purpose of this letter is to provide information pertaining to the Ribbon Pinning Ceremony. The date is May 15, 2019 beginning at 7:00pm.

Ribbon Pinning Ceremonies are a prelude to the Graduation Ceremony; however, it is a more intimate setting that includes family participation. Graduates will recite a ribbon pinning pledge and families (parents/guardians) will recite the ribbon pinning pledge for parents.

During the Ribbon Pinning Ceremony there will be a slide show presentation of the class of 2019. If you have not sent in photos of your student from zero months to date, please do so by May 10, so that your child(ren) may be represented during the presentation.

Students must wear dress attire to the ceremony. **Inappropriate attire includes clothing items such as: jeans, sweat pants, shorts, gym shoes, flip flops, etc.** Failure to dress appropriately may result in your child(ren) being excluded from the ribbon pinning ceremony. The same dress attire applies to graduation and the eighth-grade dance. Should you have any questions regarding appropriate attire please contact the principal's office.

Six Flags Great America Bag Policy

Loose articles such as purses, backpacks, and beverage containers should be left with non-riders or secured in lockers. Cell phones or other small items should be secured in cargo pockets, zippered jacket pockets, or waist packs. There is limited temporary storage available in most ride boarding areas as a courtesy to our Guests and lockers are available at the entrance to all of our major rides as an option. Each attraction has its own requirements regarding loose articles including some rides where NO loose articles are permitted. Please refer to the Safety and Accessibility Guide for a detailed list of Loose Article policies by ride.

Six Flags and its employees are not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen items and items that are lost on rides are generally not able to be located and are damaged beyond repair. For everyone's safety, we will not attempt to retrieve your item while the park is in operation.
